## From the Pastor

From the lion's den... Dear Friends in Christ and Fellow Ministers,

When Anita and I moved to a new town, we generally went church shopping. I was a lawyer at the time, so we did not limit our search to Lutheran congregations. In our second move we spent almost a year choosing a congregation. Anita shared something interesting and meaningful. As we visited neo-evangelical congregations, including megachurches, Anita shared that she really missed The Church Year. She missed the seasons of the church. We always ended up at a Lutheran congregation, so when I decided to go to seminary, it was going to be a Lutheran seminary and ordination into the Lutheran Church.

As I type this on Thursday the  $11^{th}$ , we are 10 days away from the end of the Church Year, Christ The King Sunday, on November  $21^{st}$ . The lessons for this coming Sunday, the  $14^{th}$ , are from what is called The End of Time lessons (which come at the end of the Church Year).

The Children's Sermon on Sunday the 28th, The First Sunday of Advent, will be on The Church Year and The Liturgical Colors of worship.

This is a challenging time for pastors to preach, but I hope you'll come and join us anyway as we end one church year and begin the next. This Sunday the Lesson is that at the end of time, Jesus WILL come again to judge the living and the dead. Then on the 21st, my friend and mentor, Pastor Brian Metke of Trinity Lutheran in Pell Lake, LCMC, will come and guest preach on Jesus as The King. But then, on the 28th, The First Sunday of Advent, the Prophecy/HOPE candle will be lit and the Lessons will be on The Return of The King. So, it's a challenging time to preach when the Lessons over three weeks are so closely aligned. Come and see.

I want to say a few words about Advent. Advent is an important time to put the impending Christmas rush into perspective. At the beginning of Advent, we anticipate The Second Advent of Jesus as King. "He will come again to judge the living and the dead, and His kingdom will have no end." Then, the last half of Advent returns us to the anticipation of Jesus' First Advent, God come down from heaven, born as a human baby; God with us. C. S. Lewis called this, The Incarnation, The Grand Miracle. It is the manger that makes that cross The Cross, and that tomb The Tomb.

Come and share this time of reflection on the unbelievable yet deeply true Love of God, shown not only in His death, but in His birth. Come and see. "Let every heart prepare Him room..."


