Dear Friends in Christ and Fellow Ministers,

Thank you for your prayers while I was serving in **Latvia**. Several of you have asked about the possibility of my presenting what I do in **Latvia** and how it began. I have already been invited to share this at two other congregations, so I would be happy to share with you my ministry in **Latvia**. I have asked which evenings would be best, and the consensus is either Tuesday or Thursday. We have some important meetings regarding safety in the building coming up in July on Tuesdays, so I have decided to present on my ministry in **Latvia** in the worship space on Thursday evening, **July 7**th **at 6:30 p.m.** All are invited to come and hear about what I have been doing in **Latvia** over the last 30 years of serving there.

As I mentioned before leaving in my May newsletter column, we are sharing a special sermon series this summer on the parts of worship, The Order of Worship. This series will take us through the entire summer. I will be sharing the meaning and importance of each part of our worship service. Here is the order of the sermons: June 26th: CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION; July 3rd: INVOCATION AND PASTOAL GREETING; July 10th: Our intern candidate will be guest preaching; July 17th: KYRIE; July 24th: SHARING OF THE PEACE; July 31st: HYMN OF PRAISE; August 7th: THE CREEDS; August 14th: OFFERING; August 21st: COMMUNION; August 28th: BLESSING / BENEDICTION. I hope you will make plans to join us for these special sermons on what we share together in worshipping our God.
